

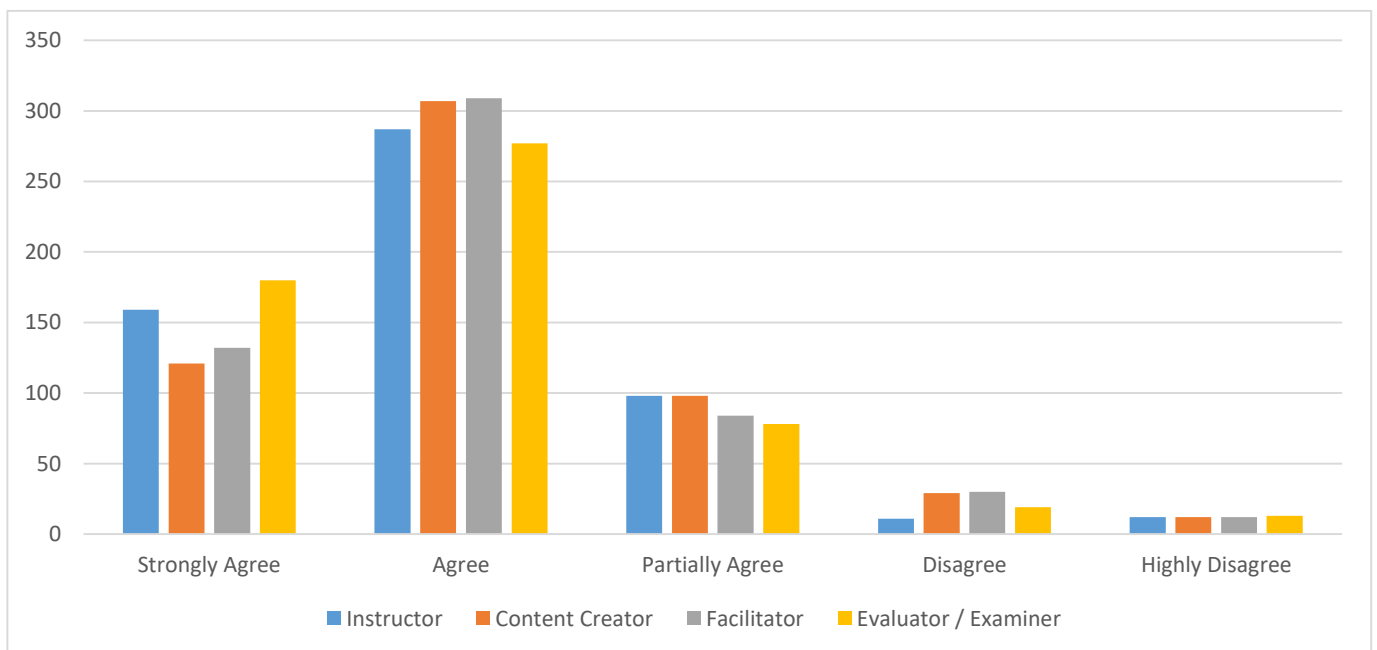

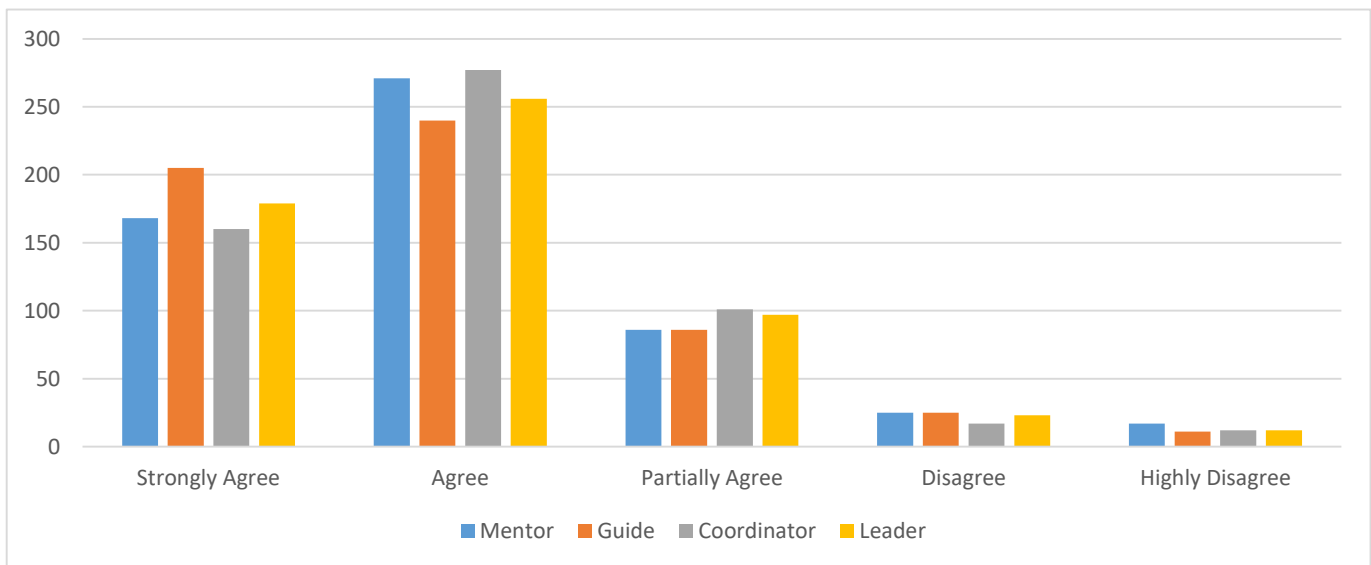
1. How much do you agree with following roles of teacher (inside classroom) in your institute?
