They can steal private information like credit card details, bank details, pictures , videos,chats and use these details to steal your money of they can even blackmail you.

The majority of cyber crimes have their sources linked with the dark web. Dark web is generally that part of internet which is not indexed on regular search engines like Google, Yahoo, Bing , etc. The dark web can be accessed using tools like the TOR browser. Dark web also known as deep web is highly anonymous due to the several layers of ip addresses hence it is used by Government Agencies to maintain privacy. The fact that Dark web is highly anonymous it also attracts the bad guys like terrorists, black hat hackers,drug dealers,etc. These bad guys use deep web to sell illegal drugs and weapons,it is used to hire professional hitmans.

We should not visit Dark web at any cost. As of now India is one of the biggest users of Torrents, India has contibution of about 11.33% of the whole torrent users.

Torrents are also linked with the dark web, generally torrents are used for piracy of movies , songs, computer applications and games,etc.To avoid purchasing the movies of computer application people just visit torrent site and download it free of cost,

but using torrents is illegal and highly insecure. A hacker can attach a payload to that file which can exploit your system or smartphone. This payloads are crafted in such a way that they can bypass all security mechanisms like antivirus and firewall and it can easily establish a reverse tcp connection with the attackers system.

The cyber crimes are increasing day by day , because the people using the samrtphones and computers are not trained properly to use them securely.

No matter how secure a smartphone or a computer is , if it is operated by a person who does not know how to use it properly , it can be exploited easily from anywhere in the world.

Hence to make Digital India a Secure Digital India , people should be trained to use modern smart devices , they should be educated about about the threats arising from these devices. Various training sessions should be arranged by the Government as well as the educational institutes.

I want to wrap up with a nice thought by Jason Silva -" Technology is , ofcourse a doubled edged sword , like fire it can cook our food but also can burn us".

All the species were indigenous, fruit bearing, shady, key stone species etc.

Morning Prayer and yoga session followed by the breakfast.

The students were exposed to field visits related to Land Capability Classification (LCC), Soil Sampling collection for preparation of Soil Health Card (SHC). The organic farming is motto of all villagers. To know the status of nutrients in the soil a scientific survey has been carries out. As per the Net Planning, a participatory planning (With farmers) has been carried out to collect the soil samples. About 100 Soil samples has been analyzed on the spot considering the availability of Nitrogen, Phosphorous, Potassium, pH and Organic carbon. The soil testing kit approved by Mahatma Phule Krishi Vidyapeeth, Rahuri was used for soil investigation. It is concluded that, all the soil samples are showing very good availability of nutrients is all the soil samples.

Some farmers have adopted innovative practices such as hydro-phonic techniques – A fodder generation technique in scarcity days of summer. One more technique of Azolla formation was developed by farmer. The students also exposed to Azolla ponds and its nutritious status for livestock. The visit to poultry farms also arranged to gather scientific information of this industry. Rejuvenation of old plantations was done and plantations of fresh saplings also done on the same day.

Day-7 (Sunday, 13th January, 2019)

The day in the NSS camp started with morning prayers and national anthem. After breakfast, the plantation has been done.

The day started with new innovative practice, Peoples Biodiversity Register (PBR). The orientation to the students was carried out regarding how to gather information about different PBR formats. NSS volunteers did this practice and completed the assignments with interacting with farmers. The assignment is guided by Dr. Chandrashekhar Pawar.

In the evening, a discussion on field work has been carried out with NSS volunteers.

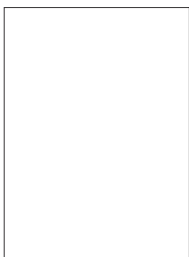

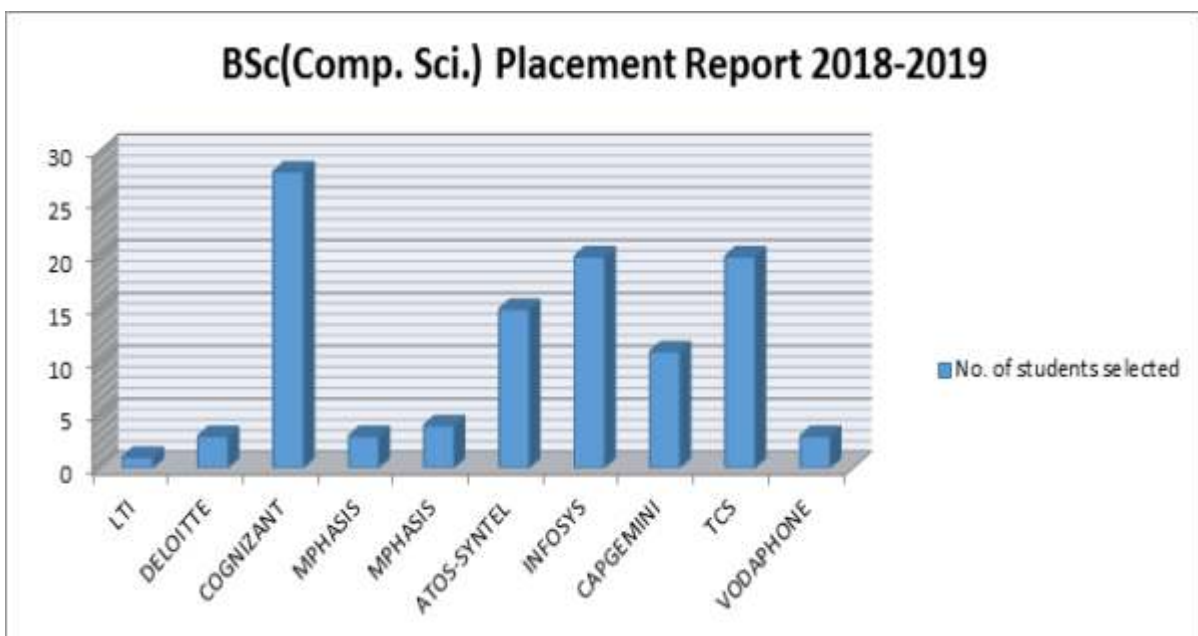

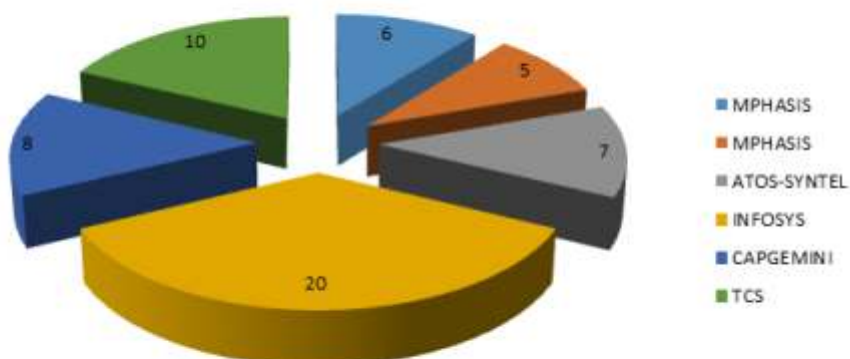

13.6 LIBRARY COMMITTEE

LIBRARY COMMITTEE:

A library authority may appoint a library committee, which is a body consisting of persons who are assigned the job of looking after the library and for transference and smooth working of library.

a) Members of the Library Committee:

The library committee is formed with the heads of the departments as well as an undergraduate student and a post graduate student, the Principal, the Librarian etc. The Principal is the Chairman of the library committee, and the Librarian is the ex-officio Secretary. The library committee should not be very large. Only those people should be included as members of the library committee who are interested in the library and in this way the membership is restricted within the limit of twenty.

b) Types of Library Committee:

There are mainly two types of library committees

- i) *Executive Committee*: This committee is most powerful as it has full power over those matters which are delegated to them by the library authority. So the decision of the library executive committee is final and mandatory. It need not report its decision to the library authority.
- ii) *Advisory or Recommendatory Committee*: It simply gives proposals which are subject to the approval of the library authority.

❖ Aims & Objectives:

The ICCS Library designed to achieve the following **broad objectives**:

- 1) To aid in the establishment of a bridge between the Library and the academic fraternity and the institute management.
- 2) To Ensure that all procedures and policies are followed as per the stated rules and regulations lay down by the concerned (UGC, AICTE, NAAC...etc.) authority.
- 3) To advice in matters regarding proposed policies.
- 4) To advise on general development and administration of the library by organizing meeting regularly.
- 5) To provide satisfaction to the users by achieving the goals of library
- 6) To support the functioning of the library
- 7) To act as a channel of communication and dialogue between the Library System and its users.
- 8) To advise and reviews library policies for instruction, resources, services, and the facility.
- 9) To discuss budgetary issues for books, journals, databases, media, etc.

1. Appointment of qualified and efficient librarian who can deliver services.
2. To assess the financial support required by the library based on library standard.
3. For providing better Services to the community and authorities and thus make an appeal for more funds for library.
4. Provide support to the librarian to defend important decisions having implications for the users (i.e. change of working hours, change in rules regarding membership and borrowing privileges etc.)
5. Bring better understanding of the role of the library among users.
6. Keep the librarian alert.
7. To make a policy for the library development.
8. To develop the library.
9. To achieve the library aims.
10. To create coordination between income and expenditure.
