AIPPM COUNCIL REPORT

Politics is a inevitable discussion. It is the representation of our hopes, beliefs and expectations. And when this hot topic is clubbed with dynamic leaders and current on goings, no one can really stay glued to their seat without expressing their views about it.

Udhav Thakre also agreed adding that article 370 was an exploitation of the very basic rights of the Kashmiri people and focused more on personal gains rather than the public. Devendra Fadnavis said that the article was "triggering", meaningless and aided corruption and terrorism. It will also lead to better emilitariz of the funds Kashmir received for over all development and it could no longer kick out India saying it was a "free country" despite using the country's resources. The motion was further backed by Amit shah, saying that the article was always meant to be temporary, and if not, then why was a detailed procedure to scrap it produced and signed. Ravishankar Prasad added that it was reason for crime and prevented the application of 106 acts like child marriage act, manual scavenging etc.

Second day at the AIPPM council, began with even more enthusiasm as the possible effects of the application of Indian constitution in Jammu and Kashmir were brought up. The motion was passed by majority and brought in several different perspectives to the same story.

Sambit patra brought up several instances of development and digitization such as the Aadhar cards, the application of 106 acts those were previously not possible. Shri Modi Ji agreed that Kashmir must be treated the same to reflect their unity, and hence their flag now matches our own. Article 370 served as a shield to corruption and crime and now we can help build better foundations and give the state access to basic rights. It is a win-win situation for all.

The other side of the coin; abuse, overlooked disappearing, curfew, increase in violence, police brutality was also brought up.



The motion of the aftermath of Article 370 on education and employment was issued by H. Kaur Badal and about the development of Ladakh. It was agreed that separate funds for Ladakh would prove beneficial for its development. Sambit patra assured that the uranium abundance in the state is kept under supervision.

Further the motion to understand the impact of the abrogation of article 370 on international relations, was raised by Udhav Thackeray.

Raj Thakre said that Pakistan and so soon, USA was involved into a matter that was supposed to be an internal matter. Even the United Nations backed India on the matter and India invited 23 MP's of the European Union into the valley. This is raised a lot of questions from the opposition. In the midst of the heated house, our chair, Abhishek acharya, had his fun and joined in with the delegates.

Political instability in the light of leadership vacuum was discussed and it was agreed that casteism further adds fuel to fire and deepens the cracks and sows seeds or sorrow and differences. Forceful Islam conversions, loss of identity of immigrants, etc were talked about. BJP called the article 'a mistake' of our late prime minister Jawaharlal Nehru. The party further pointed out that they have contributed more to the country's development in 5 years than the opposition did in over 70 years.

As for the solutions, all agree that trade and emilitarizingon should be promoted, keeping in mind the state and amount of change Jammu and Kashmir can stomach.

Shashi Tharoor stated that 'we need to take inspiration from the communist countries and supervise the market so that the companies don't go bankrupt and lead to emigration of the youth,'

Raj Thackare was in strong opposition of the high presence of army in local Kashmir and worried that it might have a bad impression on the public. He believed that the government should think about slowly emilitarizing the area. Sambit patra on the other hand, believed the opposite, claiming that it increases the feeling of safety and patriotism.

The parties finally agreed upon keeping their differences aside and coming together in the name of development of J&K, as the house passed a memo suggesting new amendments in article 370.
