With Adhiraj Karande as the director general, Sonal Manglani as Secretary General, and a passionate team of OC members, the conference was organised for 320 delegates in 6 councils to brainstorm their way to solutions for real time crises around the world.



Delegates from all over the country as well as internationally participated in the event. 14 international delegates from Japan, USA, UK, UAE, Mexico, Spain etc. were part of the event. From India 306 participated with 56 delegates from other than Maharashtra state were part of the event.

## **Objectives of I-MUN:**

- 1.) Students develop confidence and leadership skills through experience.
- 2.) Model UN conferences are opportunities to practice research, public speaking, teamwork, negotiation, and writing skills in a safe and structured environment.
- 3.) Model UN also teaches business skills – running a conference is like running a small business that involves finding “customers” (delegates), developing a “product” (the conference), and managing peers.
- 4.) The MUN is a great setting where people can try to face their fear of public speaking. This chance to overcome a fear of public speaking is great because it supports delegates’ personal growth and triggers self-confidence.

**COUNCIL: UN GENERAL ASSEMBLY-4 SPECIAL POLITICAL AND DECOLONIZATION(UNGA-4 SPECPOL) GA - 4 SPECPOL (UNGA)**

**AGENDA:** *Discussing the issue of effects of atomic radiation, bio-warfare and reviewing peace keeping operations around the world.*

The Chairperson was Abeer Tiwari and Vice Chairperson was Anshul Parekh

The United Nations General Assembly is one of the six principal organs of the United Nations, which acts as the main policy-making and representative organ of the UN.

The Meeting resolved that countries must try to carry-out sustainable R&D and progression of science, take accountability for their actions and value their signing of accords. Further, it can only be ensured by filling the gaps in international laws that address biological Warfare, specifically BWC, and the actual wish to have a peaceful international community. That seems like a big and daunting task, but till then, this will do.

The author of the first draft resolution was RUSSIA and CHINA and the authors of the second draft were USA and INDIA. Out of the total 6 resolution, only one resolution was being taken in order. And that were being made in the council. The USA used its Veto power and dissolved which failed the resolution and the council was being dissolved.

## **COUNCIL: UN WOMEN (UNW)**

**AGENDA:** *Women's Socio-economic Empowerment in Crisis prevention and recovery*

The Chairperson was Ruchira Radhe and the Vice Chairperson was Shruti Nanda

The United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women, also known as UN Women, is a United Nations entity working for the empower of women.

In the council, everyone stated solutions such as- Increase the role for civil society women networks and activists in oversight of formal structures. Prioritizing the gendered needs of women and girls in time of crises, pandemic, and conflicts. For safety purpose there should be security from government for the women who are doing service at night. Also, there must be proper medical facility in rural areas and there should be banned on abortion for an accurate population across the world! Concluding the formal discussion with the outcome provided by the fellow delegates, UNW council was adjourned.

## **COUNCIL: ALL INDIA POLITICAL PARTIES MEET (AIPPM)**

**AGENDA:** *Discussing the Implementation of Uniform Civil Code (UCC) with special Emphasis on "The medical Termination of Pregnancy Bill (MTP)"*

The Co-Moderator was Skand Bajpai and Adwait karvande

The All Indian Political Parties Meet is a powerful committee introduced in order to emulate political realities by bringing to light various layers of polity and governance in India.

Public discussion which was undertaken delegates spoke about having proper human rights to everyone and every citizen of the country. They also proposed that solid science is a need in today world and even a good step of advanced technology, for the betterment of the people. They also said that illegal method needs to be followed by, everyone and spoke about every woman needs to have their own rights and equality in general. UCC and MRT 1973, 1971 Act was also mentioned.

COUNCIL: WORLD HEALTH ASSEMBLY (WHA)

AGENDA: Discussing a framework to counter substandard and falsified medical products with special emphasis on covid-19 scenario.

The Chairperson was Arya Singh and Vice Chairperson Mohil Mehra

The main functions of the World Health Assembly are to determine the policies of the Organization, appoint the Director-General, supervise financial policies, and review and approve the proposed programme budget.

The delegate spoke on the scams and misdeeds took place which amounts to a very large number after the advent of covid-19 by selling fake masks and related products. These scammers have accumulated a lot of money from the general public who actually need money in these times of crisis.



Sating 31 million masks amid coronavirus outbreak are being exported illegally to many countries and also the neighboring areas of Asian country.

The council was in the favour of unmoderated caucus post GSL of 20 minutes. After the unmoderated caucus, the motion was raised by the delegate of USA: Introducing the working paper WHA-1.

Further the delegate discussed that the sales of falsified products should be monitored which are being sold on the digital markets. The delegate of japan initiated the idea of subsidies to victims of the falsified medicines. 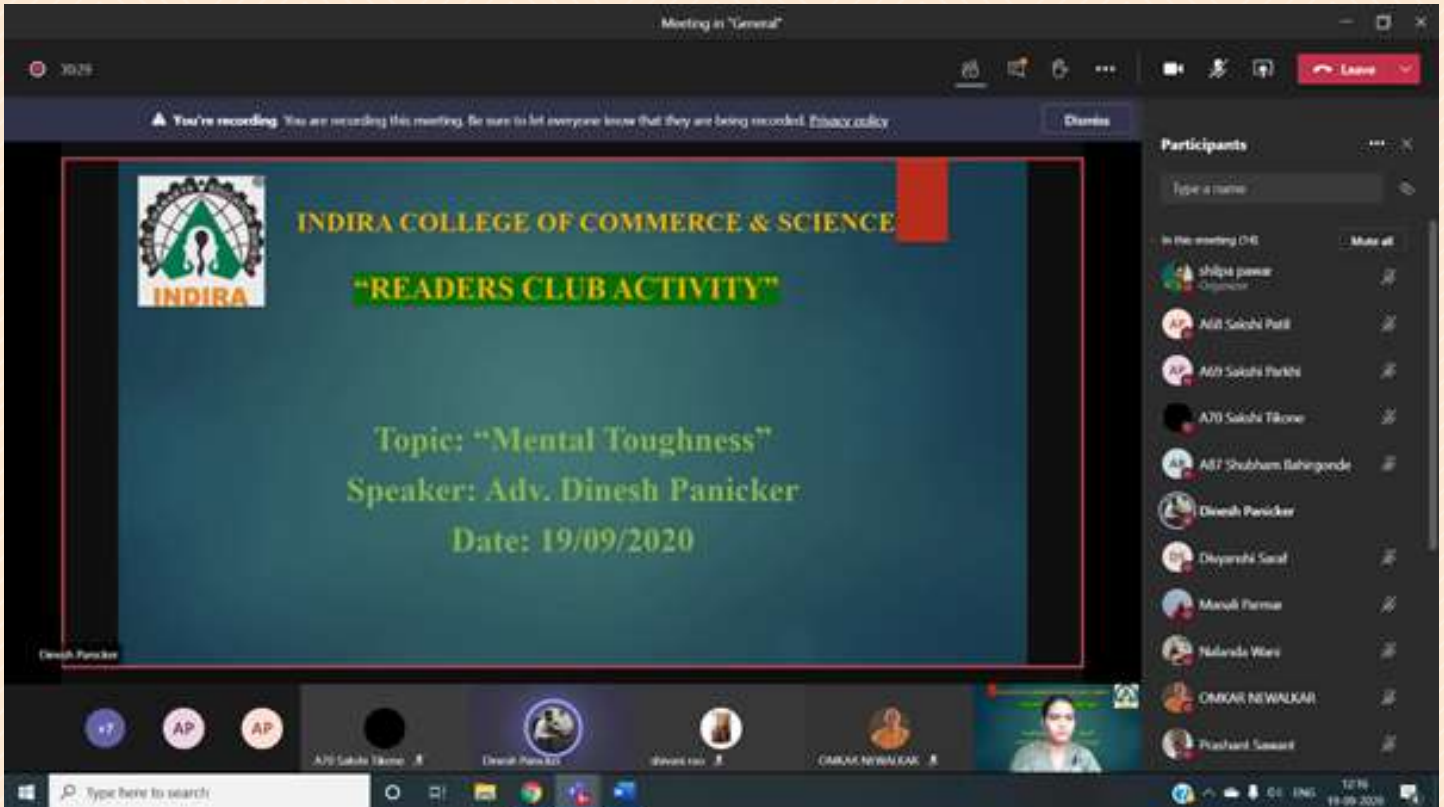


Figure 2 Readers Club Activity Session by Adv. Dinesh Panicker on " Mental Toughness"

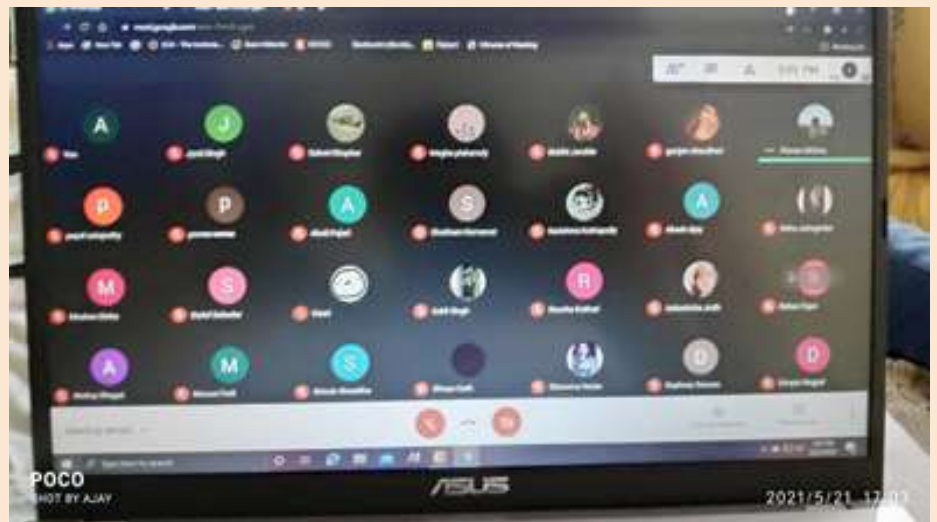
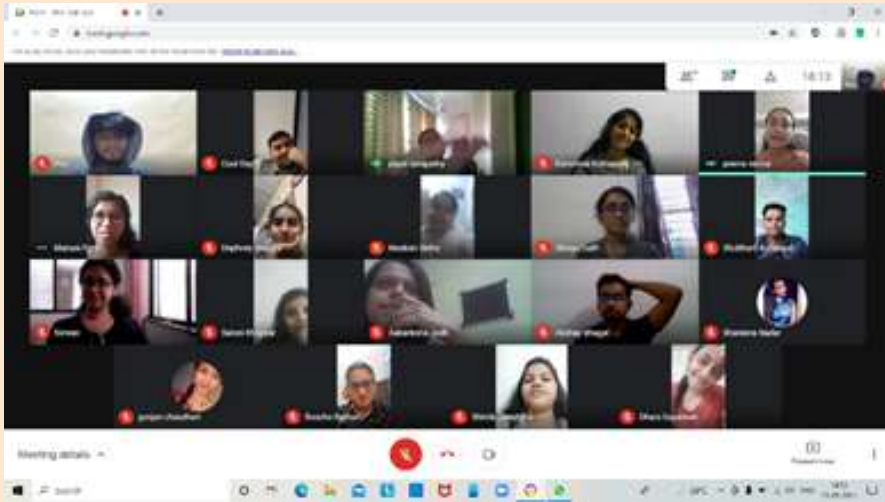
## **CHAMP CLUB**

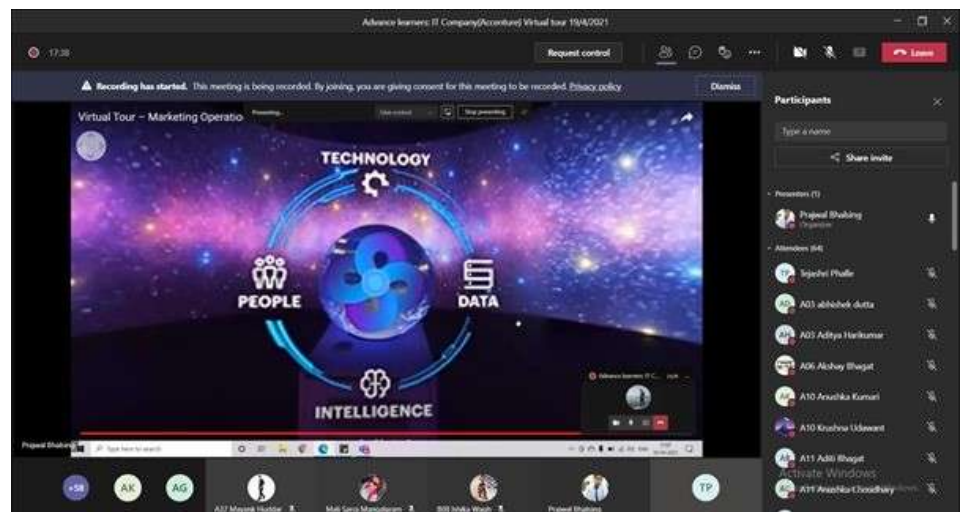


## INDUSTRIAL VISIT: VIRTUAL TOUR

### **ML IMPLEMENTATION AND NEED BY DR. GOPAL SAKARKAR**

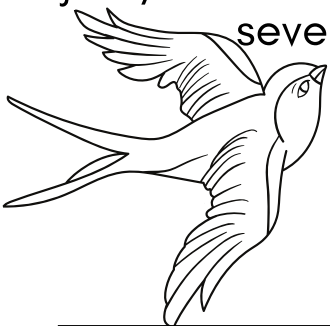

### CLOUD COMPUTING BY MR. RAHUL DESHMUKH

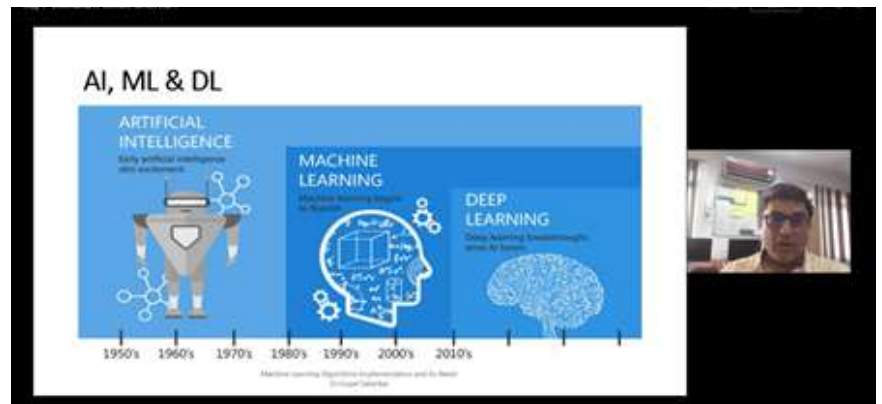

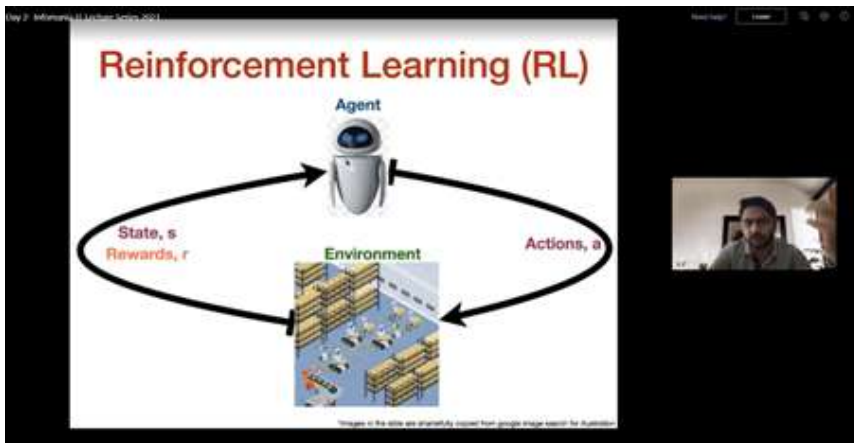
**Learning Outcomes:** Session helped participants to learn about mathematical operation that are behind several machine learning and Image processing concepts. It introduced participants to GAN.

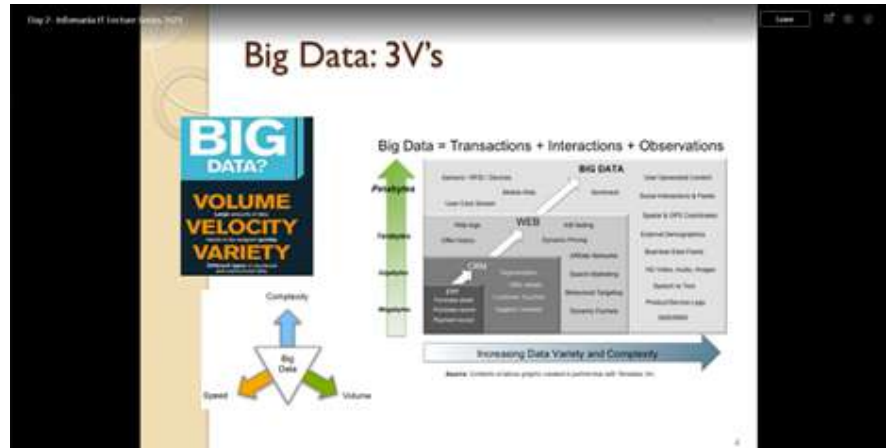

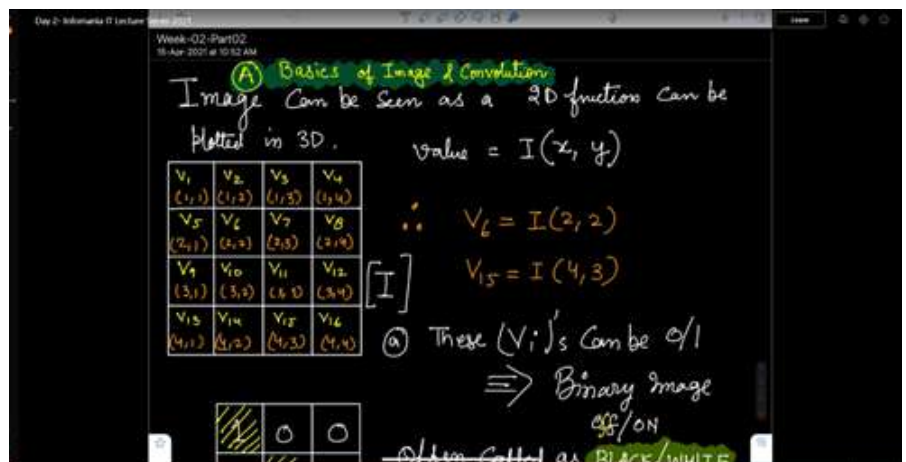

She then talks about several properties of social network like transitivity, closure, associativity etc. She explained what preferential attachment scenarios are. She also told the audience about scenarios like "friendship paradox".

## **CRYPTOGRAPHY BY DR. MAHENDRA RAMDASI**

**Learning Outcome:** Participants got the overview regarding the concepts in cryptography. several Mathematical concepts are now known to the participants that are required to do encryption and decryption.

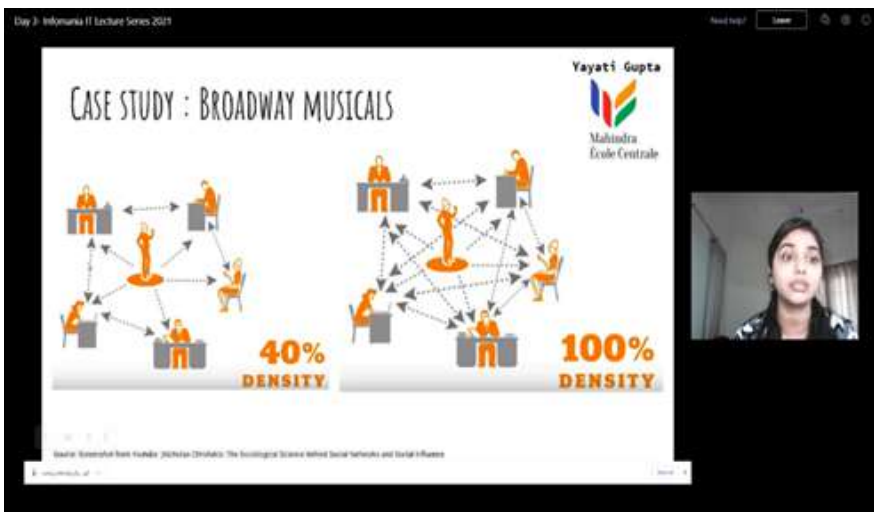

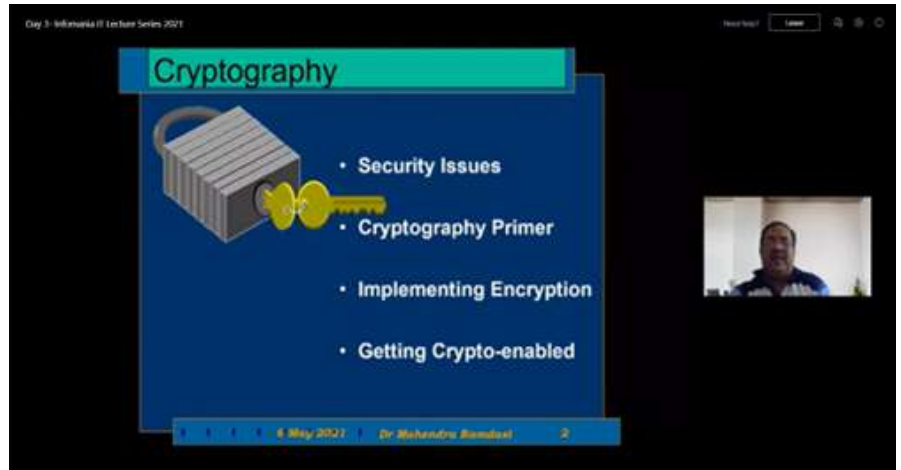

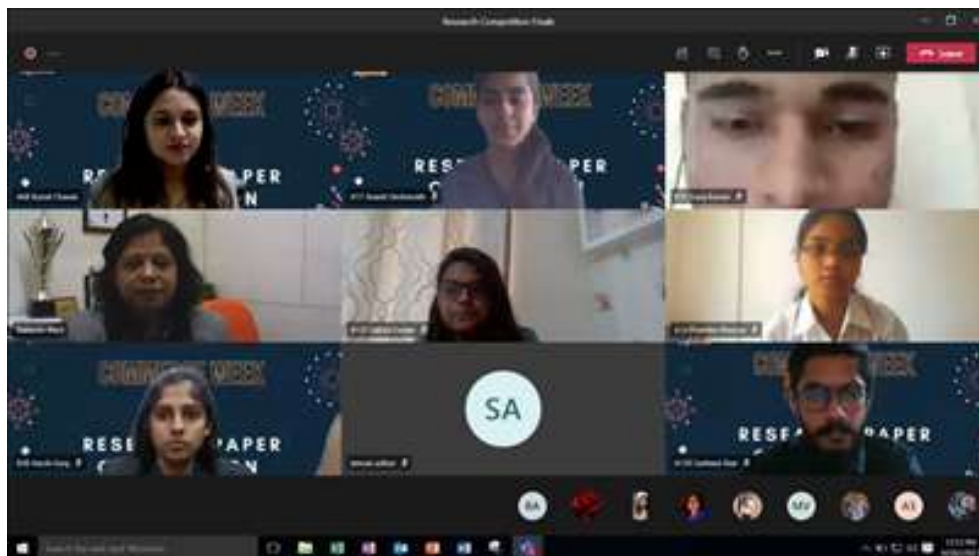

## 12. 6 Library Committee Report:

A library authority may appoint a library committee, which is a body consisting of persons who are assigned the job of looking after the library and for transparent and smooth working of library.

### a) Members of the Library Committee:

The library committee is formed with the heads of the departments as well as an undergraduate student and a post graduate student, the Principal, the Librarian etc. The Principal is the Chairman of the library committee, and the Librarian is the ex-officio Secretary. The library committee should not be very large. Only those people should be included as members of the library committee who are interested in the library and in this way the membership is restricted within the limit of twenty.

### b) Types of Library Committee:

There are mainly two types of library committees

- i) Executive Committee: This committee is most powerful as it has full power over those matters which are delegated to them by the library authority. So, the decision of the library executive committee is final and mandatory. It need not report its decision to the library authority.
- ii) Advisory or Recommendatory Committee: It simply gives proposals which are subject to the approval of the library authority

5. Bring better understanding of the role of the library among users.
6. To develop the library with achieving the library objectives.
7. To create coordination between income and expenditure.

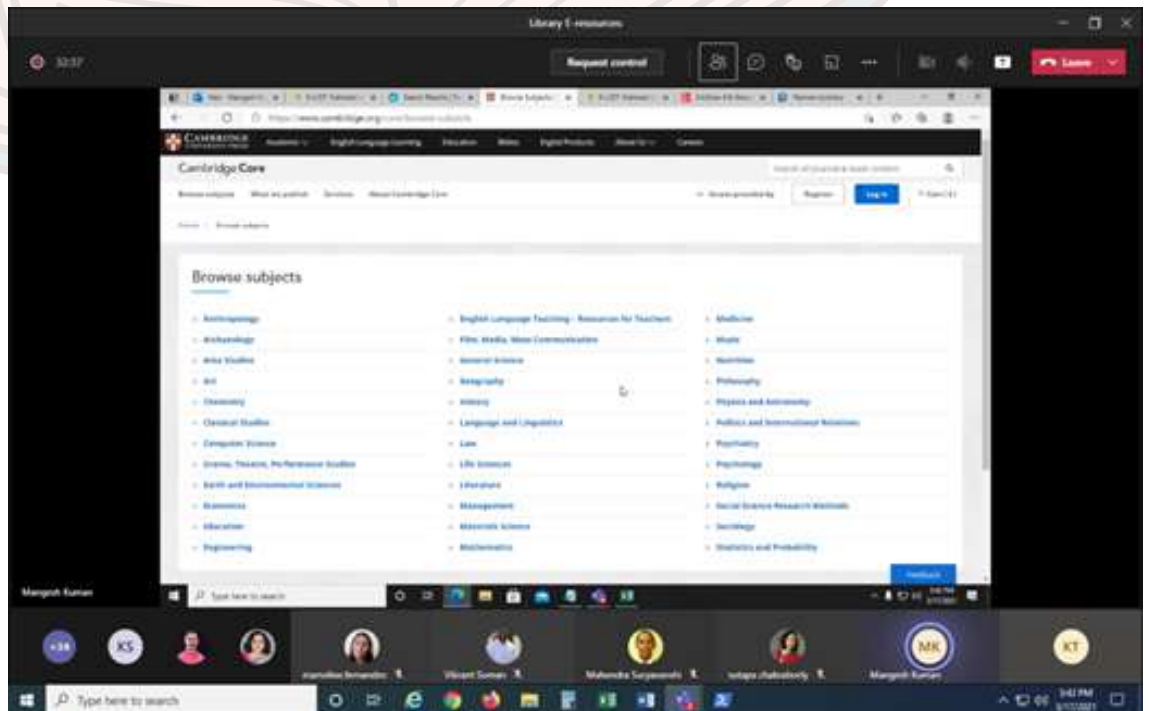

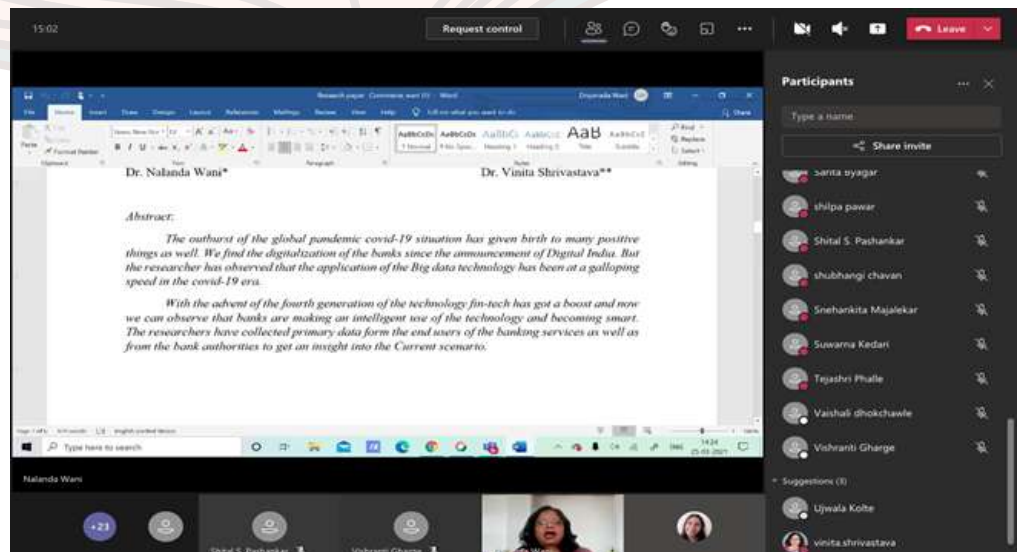
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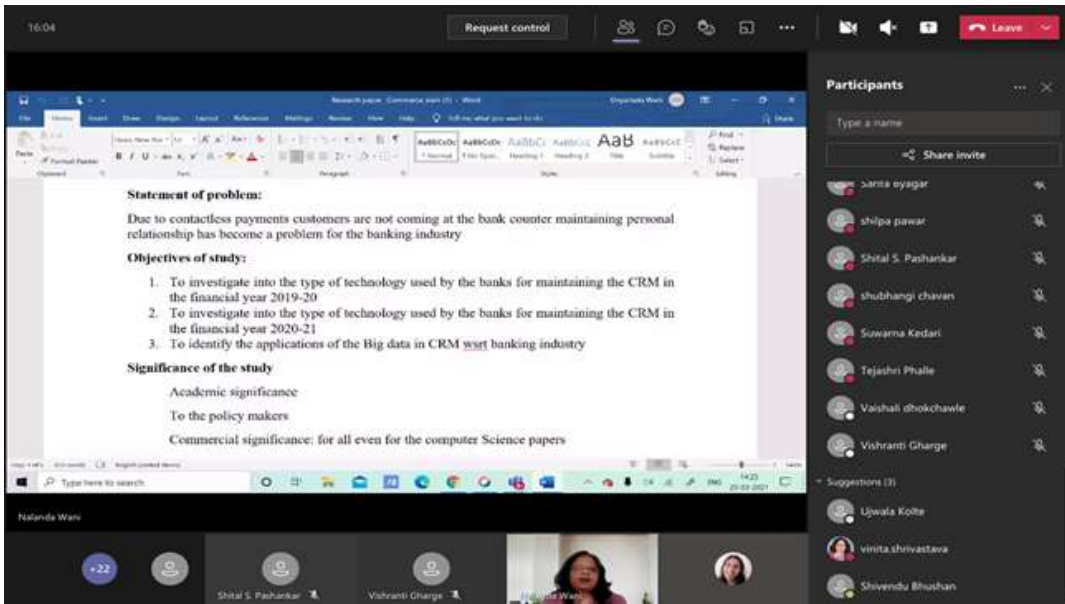


Pic 1: Dr. Nalanda Wani revising the topics discussed in the previous session

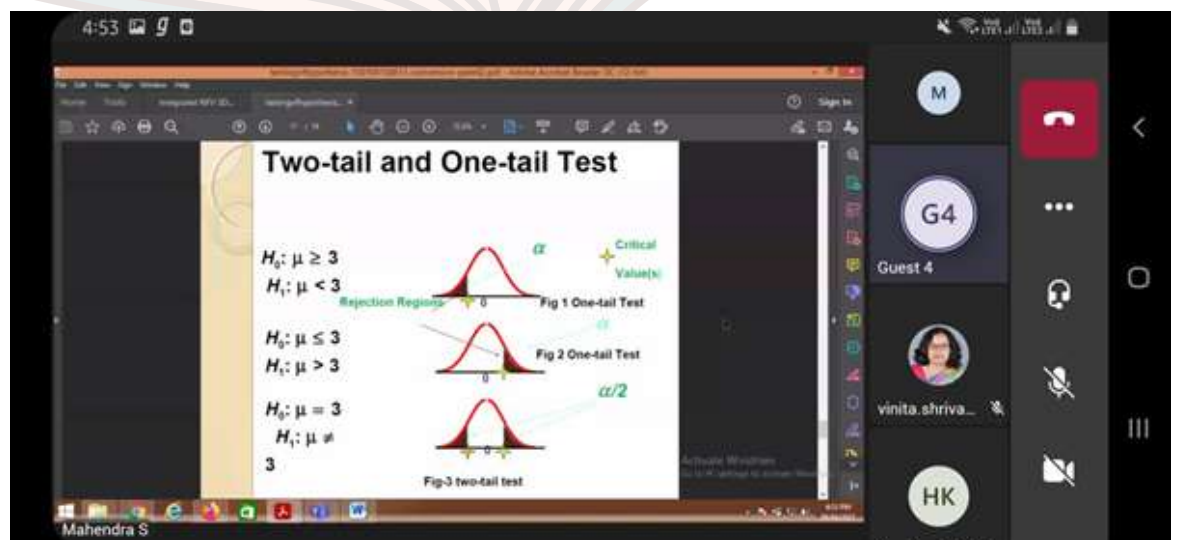
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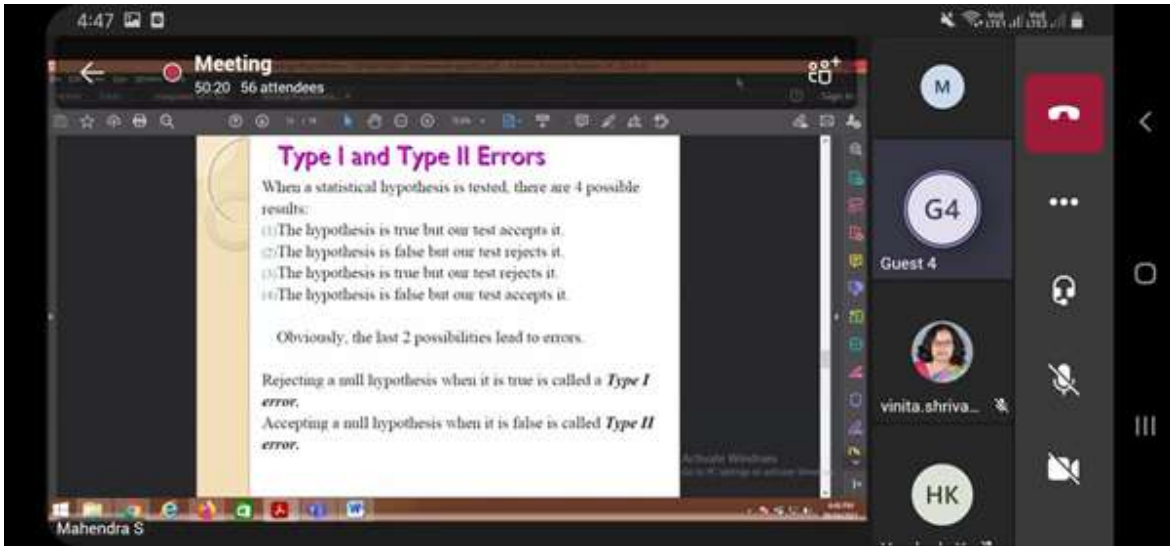


Pic 1: Dr. Suresh Pathare started the session with the topic "What do you mean by Hypothesis"
