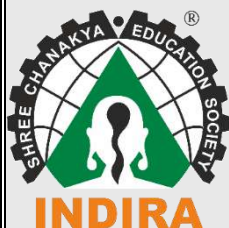

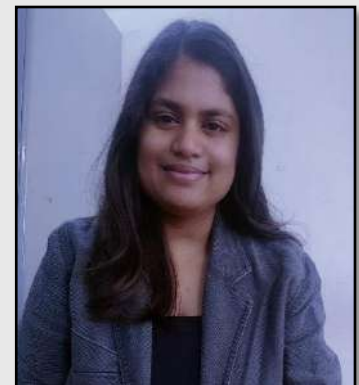

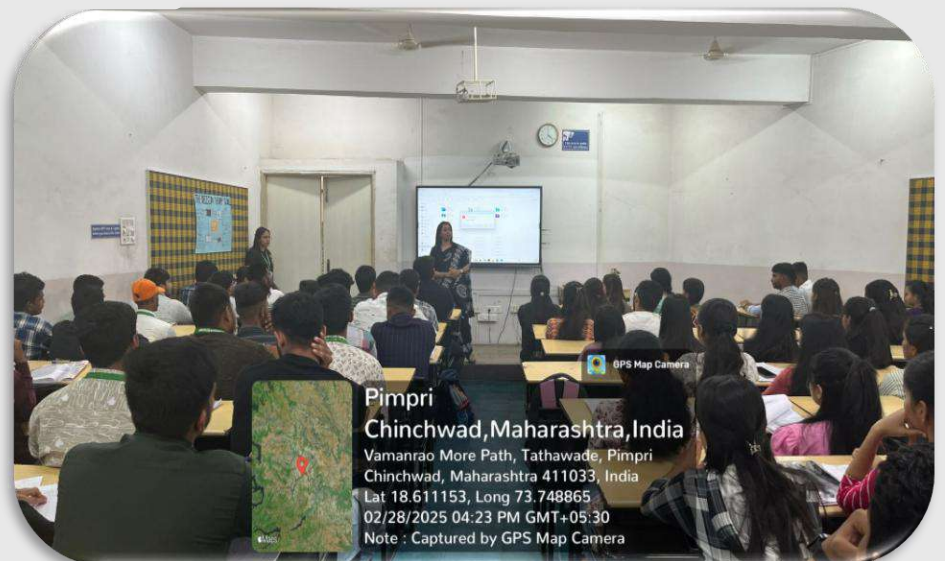

Industrial Visit of TY BBA (Finance) to RBI Museum & BSE Office on 27th Feb 25

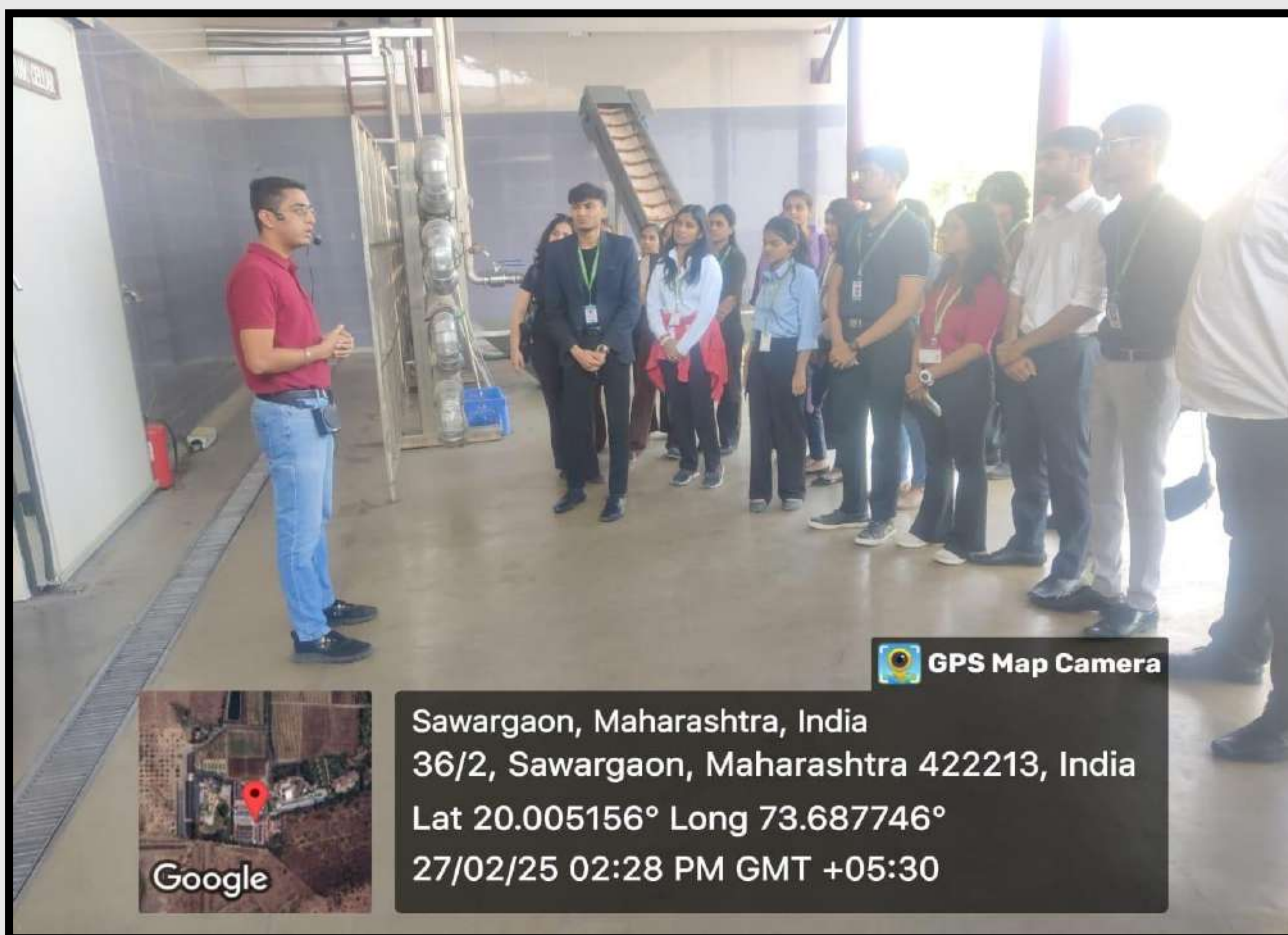

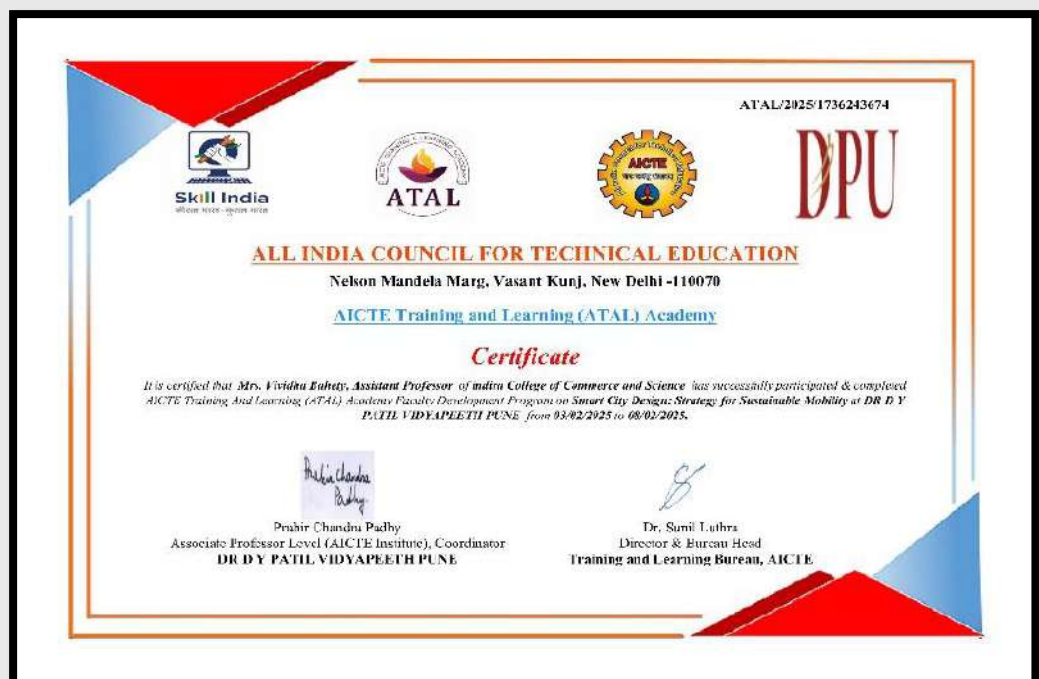
