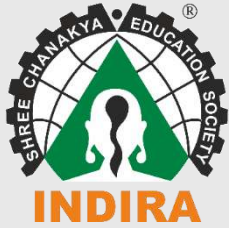

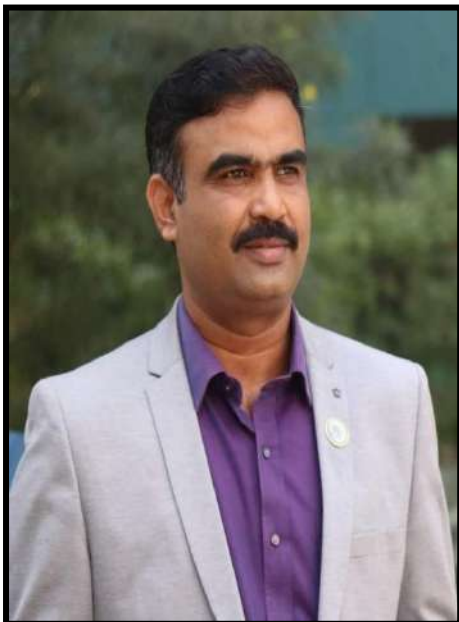
Mission statement of ICCS
