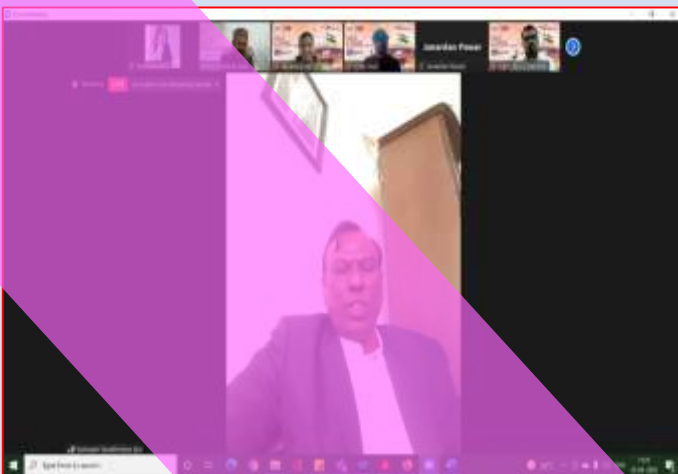

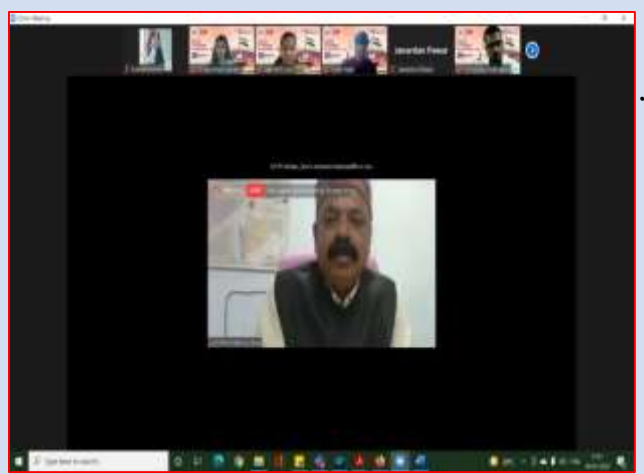

# Induction Program of Nature's Club

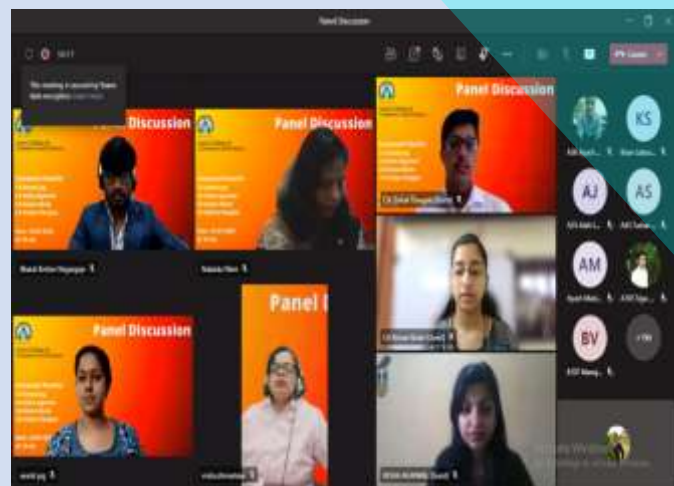

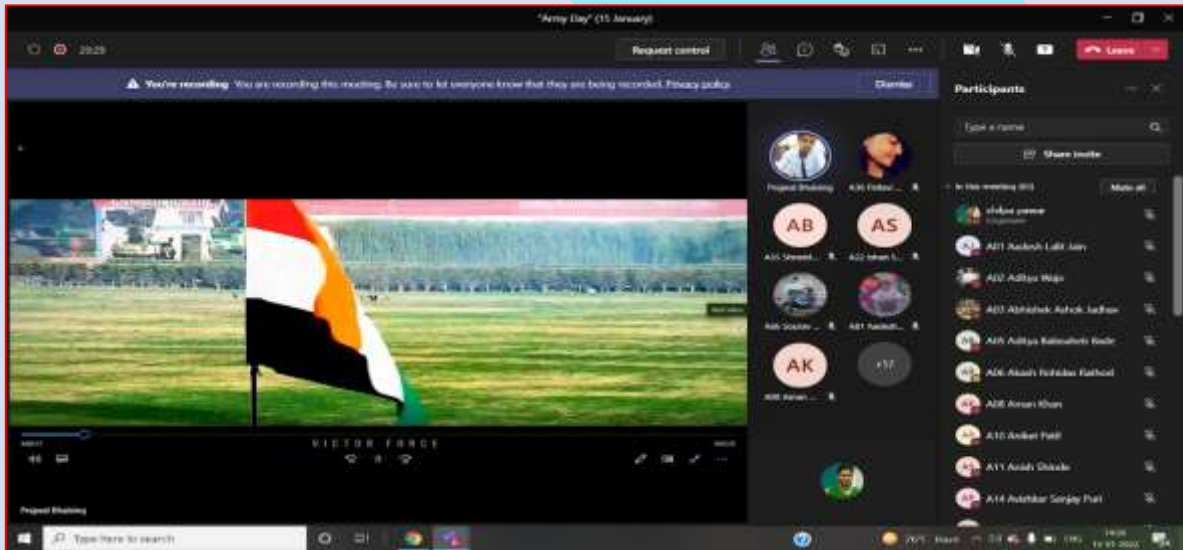

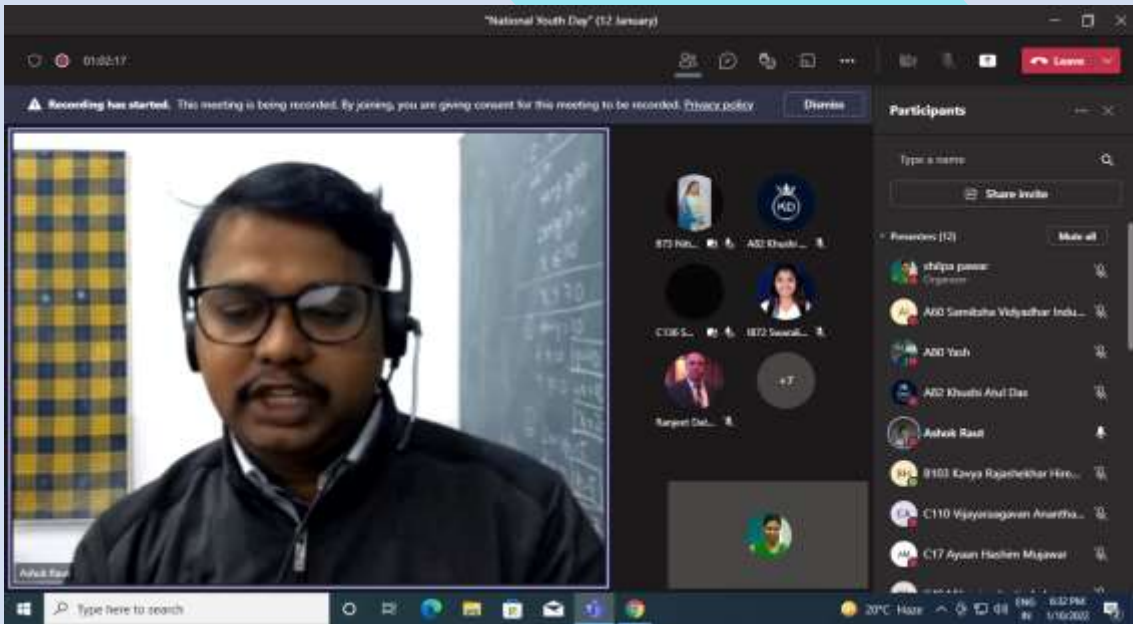
# Panel Discussion of CA Professionals

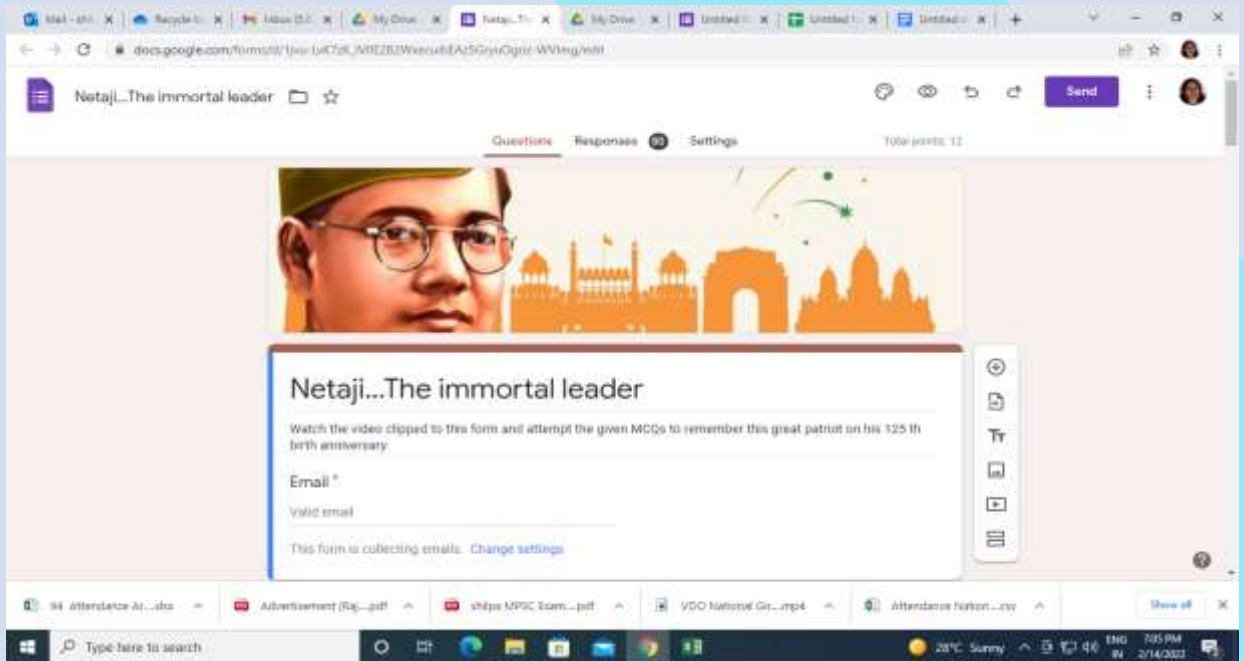
