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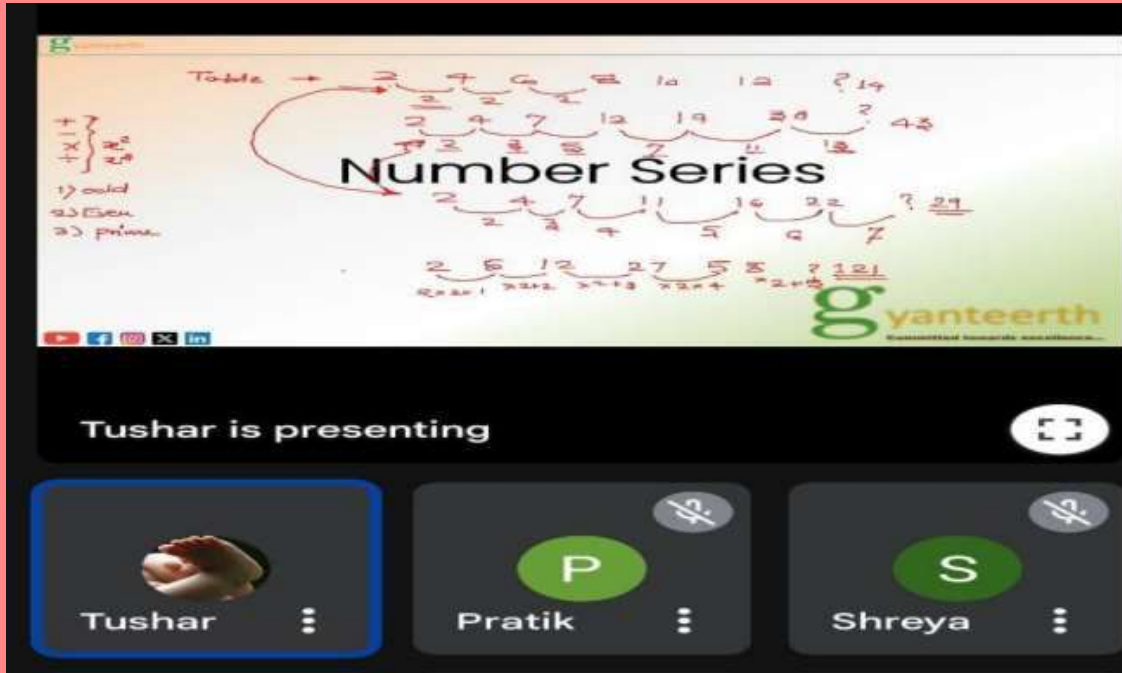

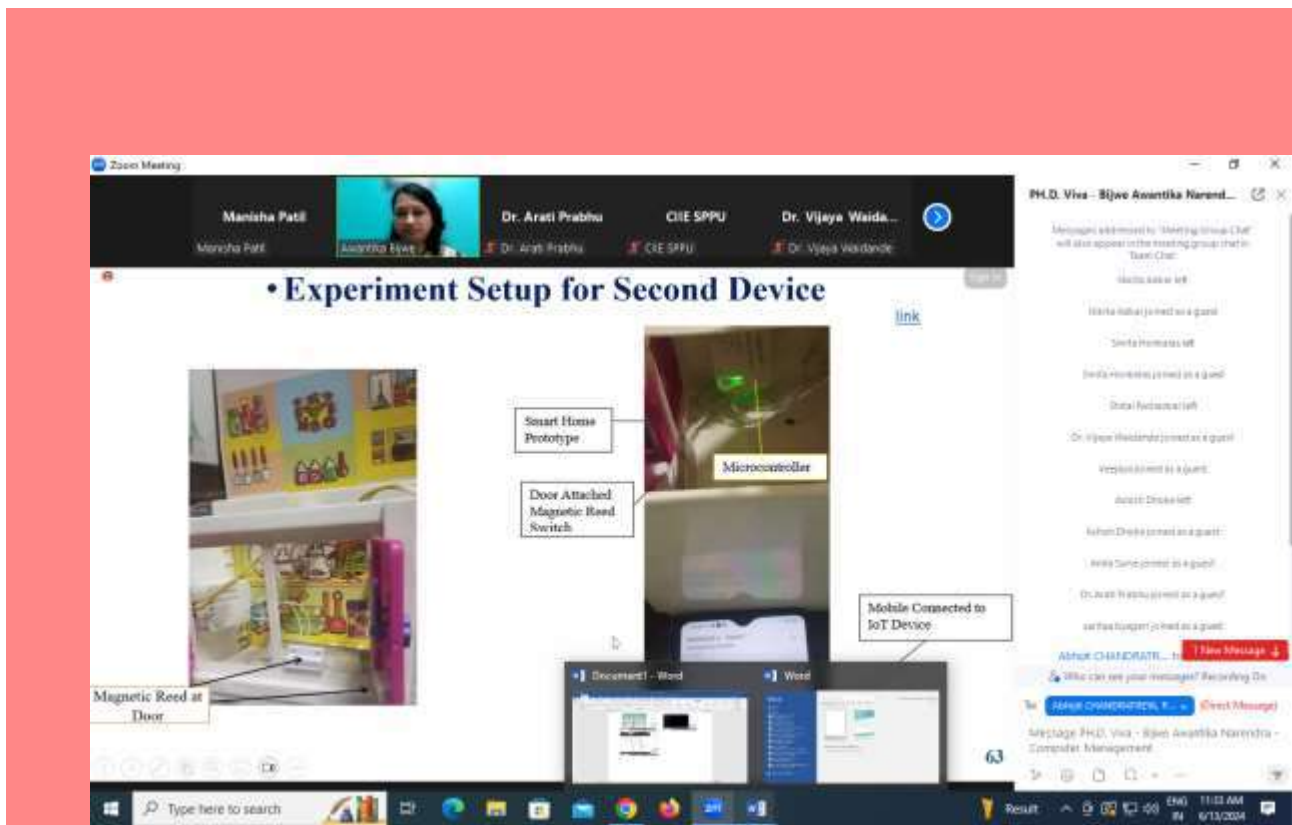
Webinar On Resiliency and Performance Engineering

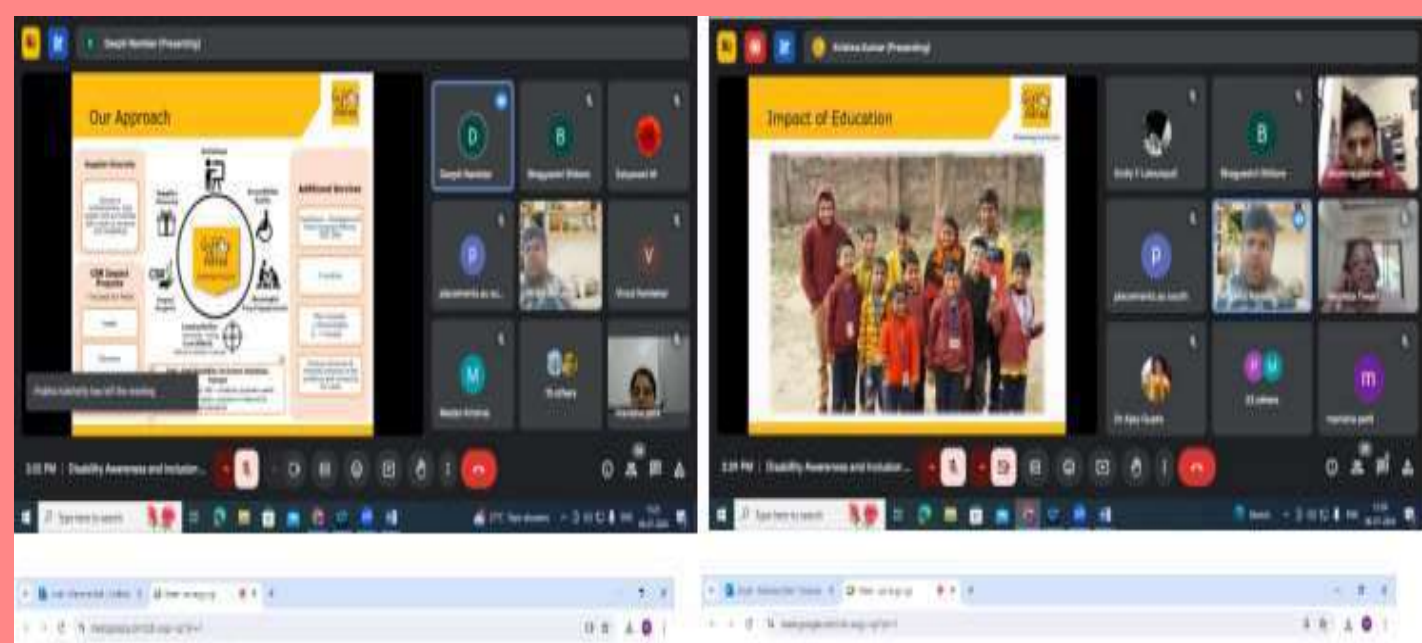

Group Presentation On Practical Applications of Accounting Standards In India

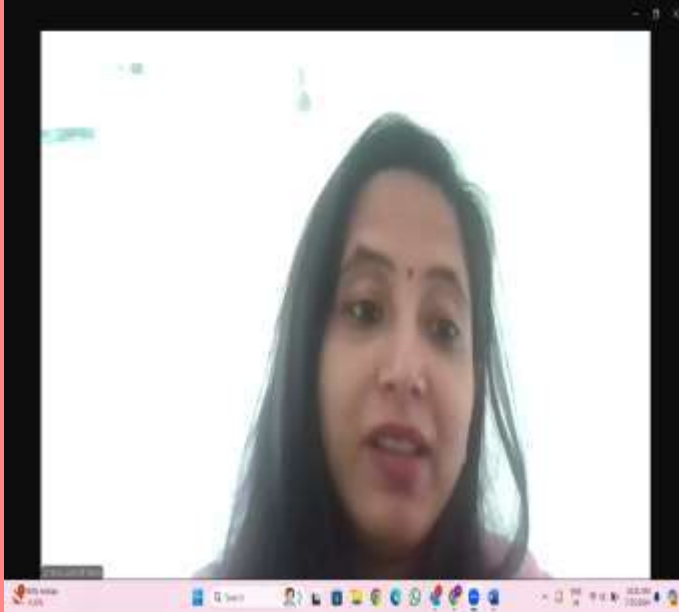

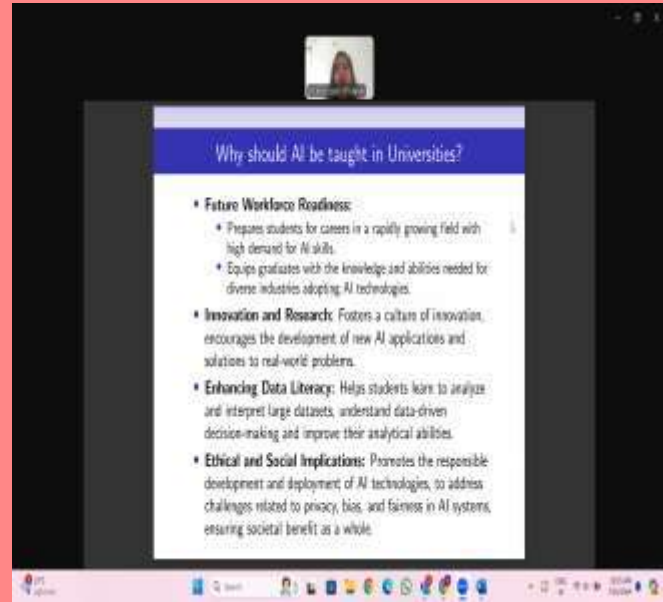
Session on Introduction to Chartered Financial Analyst
