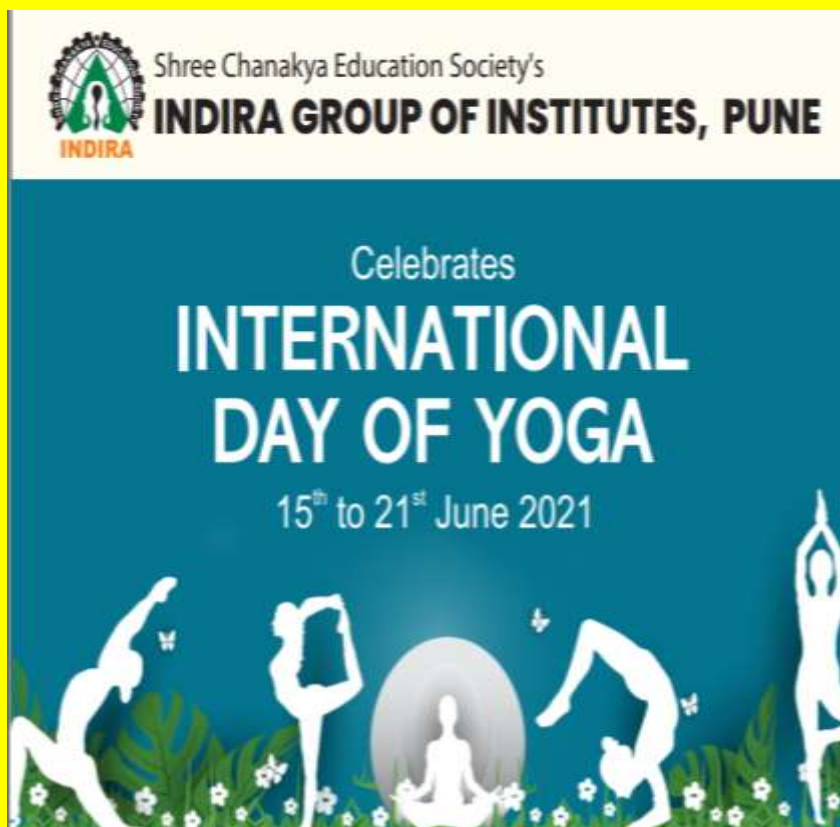

## Workshop on Seed Ball Making



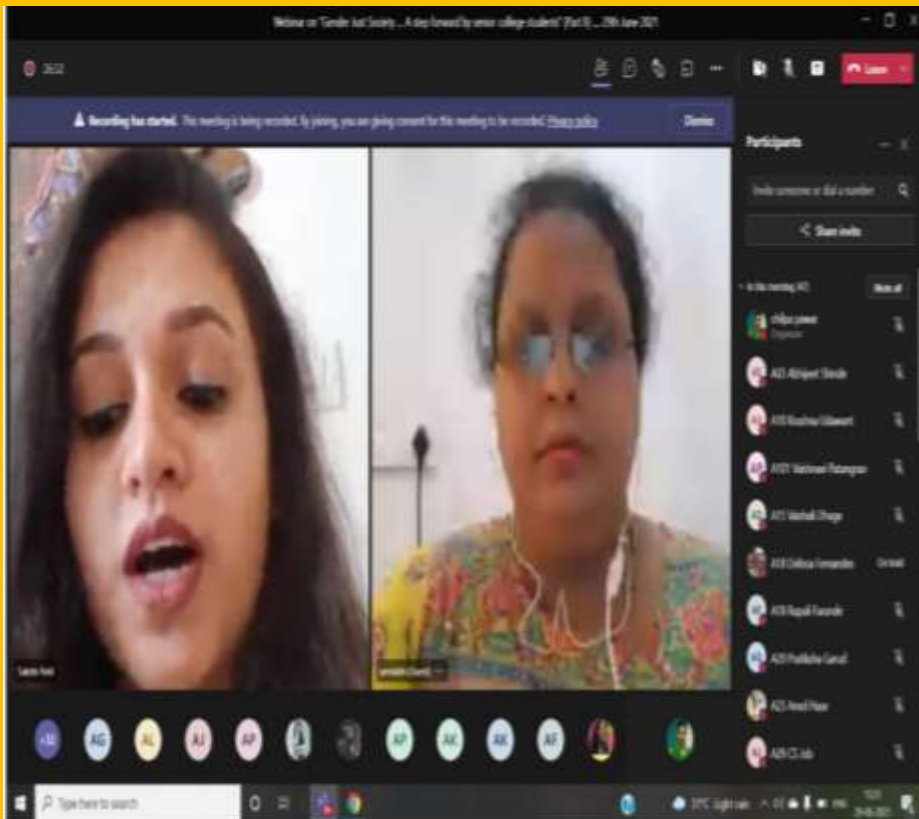

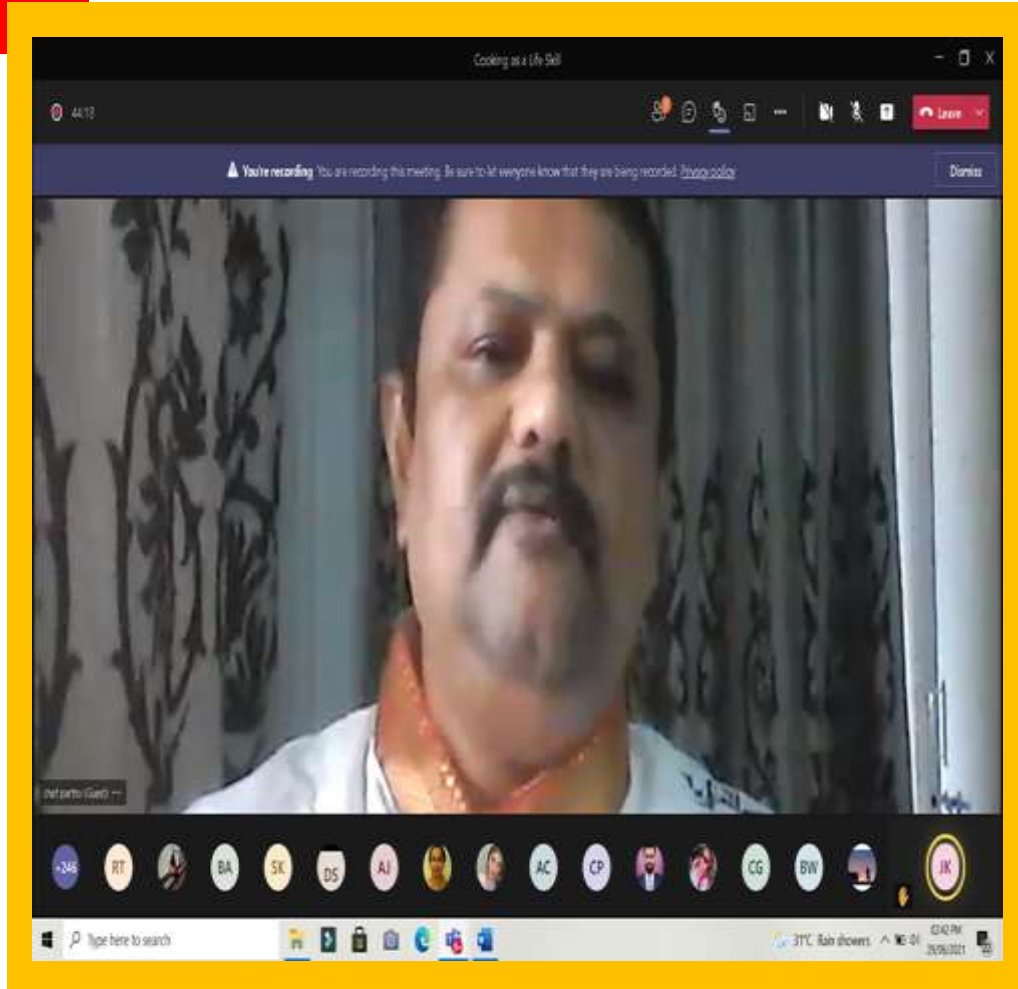

## 1. Infosys

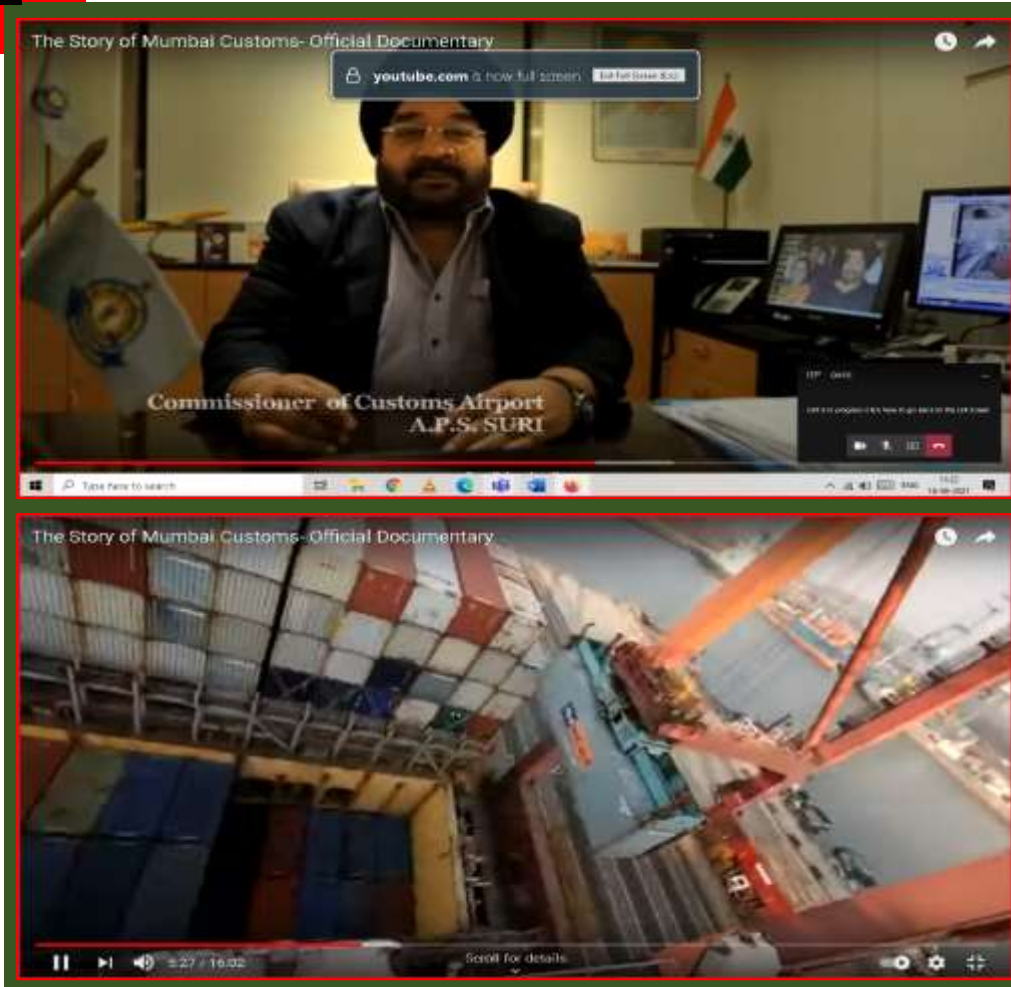
