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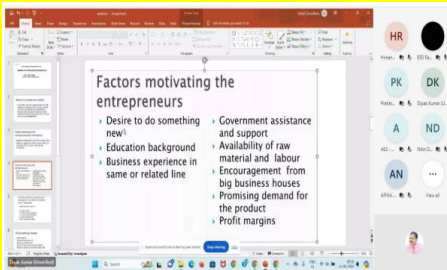
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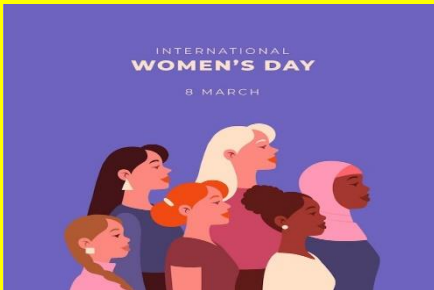
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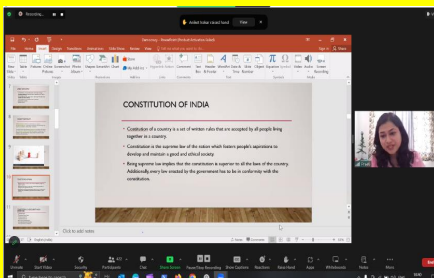
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Guest Lecture: Export Documentation

3rd March 2024

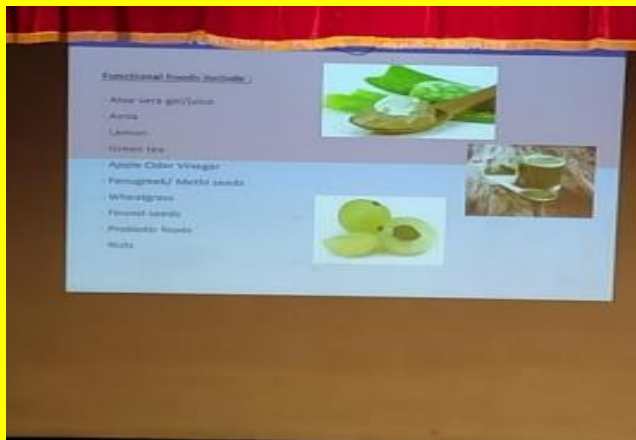

8th March 2024

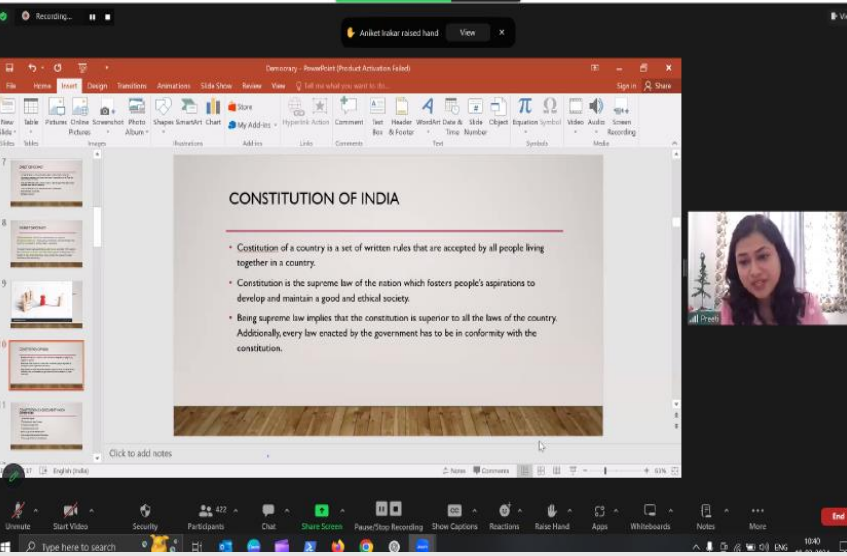

शेळकेवाडीमध्ये पर्यावरण संवर्धन समिती व इंदिरा महाविद्यालयाचे सीएसआर फंडातून ४५ घरांना सोलर कुकर, तर गवारवाडी, पिंपळोली गावनाणमध्ये १५० हून अधिक घरांना सोलर पॅनल बसवून तीन बल्ब, मोबाईल चार्जर असे युनिट बसवून दिले आहे. याशिवाय शेळकेवाडीतील जमिनीची आरोग्य पत्रिका बनवली आहे. आकडेवारीनुसार शेतकऱ्यांना खत मात्रा किती द्यावी, याबाबत मार्गदर्शन करण्यात आले आहे.

ताथवडे येथील इंदिरा महाविद्यालयाचे राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना शिबिर १० ते १७ फेब्रुवारीमध्ये शेळकेवाडी पिंपळोली येथे उत्साहात पार पडले. या शिबिरात महाविद्यालयाच्या पन्नास
