Model Code of Conduct for Staffs	2020-21	<ul> <li>(i) Every Teacher shall discharge his/her duties efficiently and diligently to match with the academic standards and performance norms laid down by the College Management from time to time.</li> <li>(ii) Every Teacher shall update his/her knowledge and skills to equip himself/herself professionally for the proper discharge of duties assigned to him/her.</li> <li>(iii) Every Teacher shall conduct himself/herself with absolute dignity and decorum in his/her dealing with the superiors, colleagues and students every time.</li> <li>(iv) No teacher shall absent himself/herself from duties at any time without prior permission from higher concerned authorities.</li> <li>(v) No teacher shall accept any honorary or other assignment given to him/her by any external agency without the prior permission of the College Management.</li> <li>(vi) No teacher shall associate with any political party or take part in any other organizational actively, which is not in line with the duties and ethics of the teaching profession.</li> <li>(vii) No teacher shall attempt to bring any political or outside pressure on his/her superior authorities in respect of service matters.</li> </ul>

The main purpose is to achieve &amp; maintain safe &amp; healthy Campus environment with the objective of resuming normal college operations to the maximum extent possible. Employees &amp; Students of Indira college of Commerce &amp; Science that Violate the code of conduct or fail to follow any requirements applicable to them may face disciplinary action pursuant to the Code of conduct.</li> <li>Students/Employees Requirements:</li> <li>1. Student/ Employee must have completed two doses of Vaccination drive &amp; should carry the certificate of the same before arriving on the campus for the year 2021-2022. It is mandatory for students joining the Hostel to</li> </ul>

bring certificate of Negative RT-PCR test.
2. Student/Employee must Participate & comply
with the ICCS health screening processes &
policies before arriving on the campus for the
year 2021-2022.
3. Student/Employee must participate & comply
with ICCS daily self-monitoring requirements.
4. Student/Employee must wear mask whenever
in Campus & should carry one additional
mask also for replacement if required.
5. Student/Employee must carry & keep personal
hand sanitizer with them all the time & should
regularly use it especially before & after use
of bathroom, eating, touching of public
surfaces & before & after touching eyes, face
or mouth.
6. Student/Employee must maintain physical
distancing of 6 feet from others whenever
feasible.
7. Student/Employee must regularly wash their
hands with soap & water for 20 sec or more
especially after using bathroom & before &
after eating.
8. Student/Employee must not participate in any
unnecessary travel off Campus & if travelling
they should continue physical distancing &
mandatorily wear face masks when in the
presence of others.
To reduce the risk of spread of infection, ICCS have
introduced a number of important check points.
Examples include:
