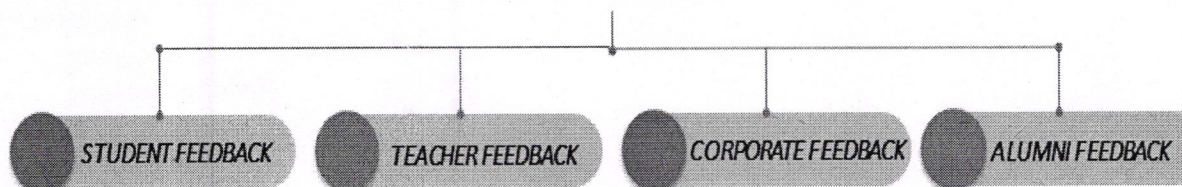

Teachers give their feedback to improve the teaching learning process and enhance the quality of curriculum.

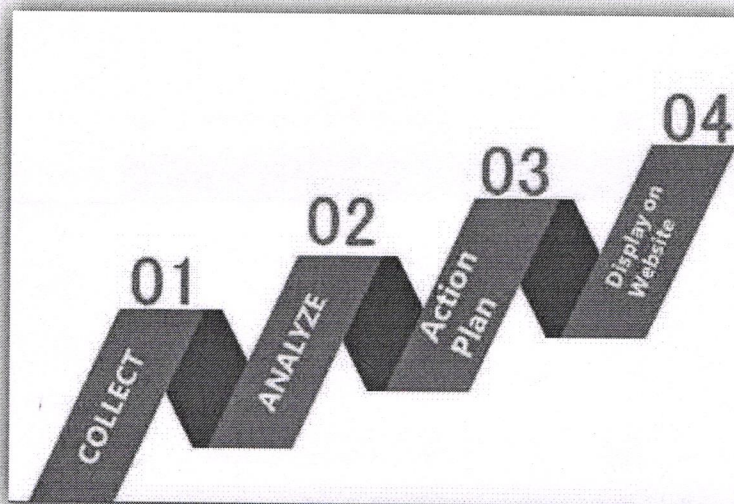
Many **employers** visit the college for recruiting students, after the recruitment procedure they share their overall experience.

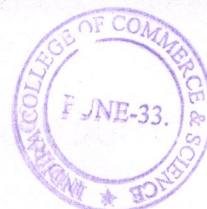
The responses thus received from the different **stakeholders** are then analysed in order to improve overall quality of learning, academic standards, system of administration and maintenance of academic disciplines.
