

Further college has established ERP mechanism in order to have online and timely collection of feedback from the **students**. The feedback thus received is placed before IQAC for consideration and also action to be taken is discussed. HOD takes feedback of the faculty twice in a semester from **students** and analysis is done. If feedback is poor, then corrective measures are advised by HOD and Principal.


**Teachers** give their feedback to improve the teaching learning process and enhance the quality of curriculum.







2. How will you rate Your Syllabus?




3. The Sequence of the courses (Subjects) in the Curriculum







4. Size of syllabus in terms of the load on the Student.



5. Were you able to get the expected depth of the course content?




**6.** How the Content of the courses is encourages extra learning /Self Learning?








2. Is the learning objectives are clear and appropriate to the program?


